OUR PROGRAMS:

MRCP/MRCS-UK Pathway

This is a two year training programme that aligns with the Core Medical training of the United Kingdom. It is mandatory for the trainees to work in acute medicine and allied specialities in multi-speciality hospitals. Our focus is on training, not coaching for exams. At Osler's passing the exam is a collateral benefit ! Most of the teaching is 'hands on' with trainees being tutored from a very basic level such as history taking, physical examination and case sheet writing. The surgery program, however, doesn't offer full hands-on surgical training & hence it should be considered as just a stepping stone for further training in the U.K.

MRCP-UK PATHWAY (In Partnership with RCP - Edinburgh)

As a testimony to our commitment to Postgraduate Training, the College offers to place a select number of trainees who have passed MRCP Part1, into hospitals in Scotland or the Northeast of England as a part of Medical Training Initiative (MTI) Programme. In this Pathway, trainees who meet all the selection criteria will be considered for the RCPE MTI interviews. Successful trainees will get an NHS job with a Tier 5 visa for 2 years and GMC registration.

MRCP-USA Residency Pathway

For all aspirants of the US career Osler's Clinical Primer will help improve clinical skills and work experience, and after obtaining qualification of MRCP-UK help in finding jobs in the United Kingdom through our tie up institutes

This pathway will help immensely; as entry into the USA from the UK is much easier than entry directly from India without any clinical experience.
